Summer Pasta

Ingredients

4 tablespoons of olive oil 2 tablespoons of butter 1 tablespoon lemon juice 1/2 teaspoon of thyme 1/2 teaspoon of oregano 4 cloves of minced garlic 1/2 of a yellow onion minced 1/2 red bell pepper sliced 1/2 yellow crookneck squash, 1 can of artichoke hearts 10 spears of asparagus halved 4 carrots chopped

1/2 package of your choice of

Saute the onion in the olive oil and butter on medium heat until soft and browned. Add the garlic and cook until you can smell the delicious garlic aro-ma. Start boiling your noodles and add a teaspoon of salt to the water. Add carrots and leave on medium heat until tender but not soft Add remaining ingredients and combine until coated with sauce and lightly cooked through. Once all of the veggies are cooked, add the pasta to the pan or a large



bowl and mix. You may need to add more butter or oil at this point depending on the pasta used. Add salt and pepper to taste and enjoy!
