CHECK OUT WHAT'S NEW!

Dr. Ott has always made sure to keep up on the latest advances in dentistry. 20 years ago he was the first dentist in St. George to stop using the mercury (silver) filling material and the office has been mercury free since. He also was one of the first to start using an intra-oral camera (it was the size of a mini-fridge, our new camera is more like a large pen). This past year we have made some upgrades to our office in making sure

we are current with the best care available for our patients. One of the things we are most excited about is our switch to digital x-rays. With the purchase of the digital panorex we have been able to be completely film free, no more dark room. Some of the benefits out patients see from this are:

Less radiation - Dental x-rays have gotten better in the past years but the switch to digital minimizes the radiation even further.

Less waiting - No more waiting around for films to develop which means shorter appointments and less time in the dental office and no one complains about that.

Better diagnosis- Not only does it help the doctors see better, but our patients can see the same things we are looking at and can be more involved in the treatment plan.

Environmentally friendly- No more chemicals and disposable lead packets.

We have had a major advancement in dental materials. Our lab has started making crowns that are made of zirconia. It is an all porcelain crown that is made using a CAD/CAM process which has made the precision and fit of these practically perfect. Because they are all one piece, unlike the metal to porcelain crowns, they don't chip or break. They are so strong we can use them on the hardest grinding patients and don't have to worry about them failing. We finally have a good alternative to gold crowns, a new gold standard. We also got a new laser this year. Our doctors love it because for surgery it allows the least traumatic, blood free procedure while also being precise. Our patients have loved it because we have had great success treating cankers, cold sores, and other mouth sores.



Two of our team members welcomed new babies this past year! Larissa and her husband, Travis, welcomed their second child, Carter, on August 24th. While Shauni and her husband, Landon, are experiencing parenthood for their first time with the arrival of Ace on February 16th. Shauni will be seeing patients again starting April 20th.
